

READING PATHWAYS

Individual and Group Reading Instruction

Reading Pathways groups are organized to assist children at various stages of reading development.

- Groups meet weekly or bi-weekly
- Low adult/child ratios
- Individual treatment plan for each child
- Comprehensive testing is available (but not required for participation)
- A brief parent consultation (30 minutes) is required to determine eligibility and assist with group placement at a fee of \$65.00
- Groups are lead by a licensed pediatric speech-language pathologist and/or certified reading specialist
- Lindamood-Bell Programs (LIPS, Seeing Stars, Visualizing & Verbalizing, Cloud Nine)
- Offer a supportive peer environment
- Include sensory-motor activities



Who Can Benefit from Reading Pathways?

- Groups are available for elementary, middle and high school ages
- Excellent for children with learning disabilities (dysgraphia, dyslexia, etc.), sensory disorders, Asperger's syndrome, and related challenges.

Reading Pathways Jump Start Group

- Appropriate for Pre-K through second grade.
- Target pre-reading skills of letter identification, sound-letter correspondence, phonological awareness, phonemic awareness, early reading skills and overall literacy expansion.

Reading Pathways 1, 2, 3

- Designed for older students who may not have mastered phonological awareness, phonemic awareness, decoding words, spelling, writing, reading fluency and reflective reading.
- Children are grouped with age-related peers.

1:1 Reading Pathways

- Individual work with Jocelyn Davey, a local reading specialist who has a Master's Degree and is a Certified Reading Specialist.
- Currently offering complete reading assessments (i.e., Woodcock Reading Mastery Test) as well as individual therapy utilizing multi-sensory approaches, including Lindamood-Bell.

Fast ForWord Programs

- Individual and group programs offered.
- Program can be completed on a home computer or in our computer lab during the summer.
- Comprehensive testing is required for FFW program qualification at an additional cost.
