



Understanding Your Right to A Good Faith Estimate

At Speech Pathways, we believe in transparency and helping families plan confidently for their child's care. Under the No Surprises Act, if you are uninsured or choosing to pay out of pocket, you have the right to receive a Good Faith Estimate of the expected cost of services before your first appointment.

A Good Faith Estimate outlines the anticipated charges for your scheduled care. It is not a bill. It is a helpful planning tool designed to give you clarity, help you prepare, and avoid unexpected costs.

Your estimate may include:

- The primary service(s) you will receive
- Any related services that are reasonably expected during your visit or treatment period
- If additional appointments, such as evaluations or therapy sessions, are scheduled at a later time, you may request a separate Good Faith Estimate at any point.

You have the right to:

- Receive your estimate in writing and in your preferred format (email, printed copy, large print, etc.)
- Request an estimate before scheduling care
- Compare the estimate to your final bill and dispute charges that are \$400 or more above the estimated amount
